history

209 W Jackson is a 12-story brick building that was built in 1898 and designed by Architect Charles Sumner Frost, who also designed Navy Pier. The building still maintains its original construction and character with granite-faced columns and a terrazzo lobby. Efficient floor plates offer a great opportunity for small-to-mid-sized tenants looking for excellent window lines and elevator identity. Amenities include Starbucks, Luke's Beef, Panda Express, and a Sundry shop.

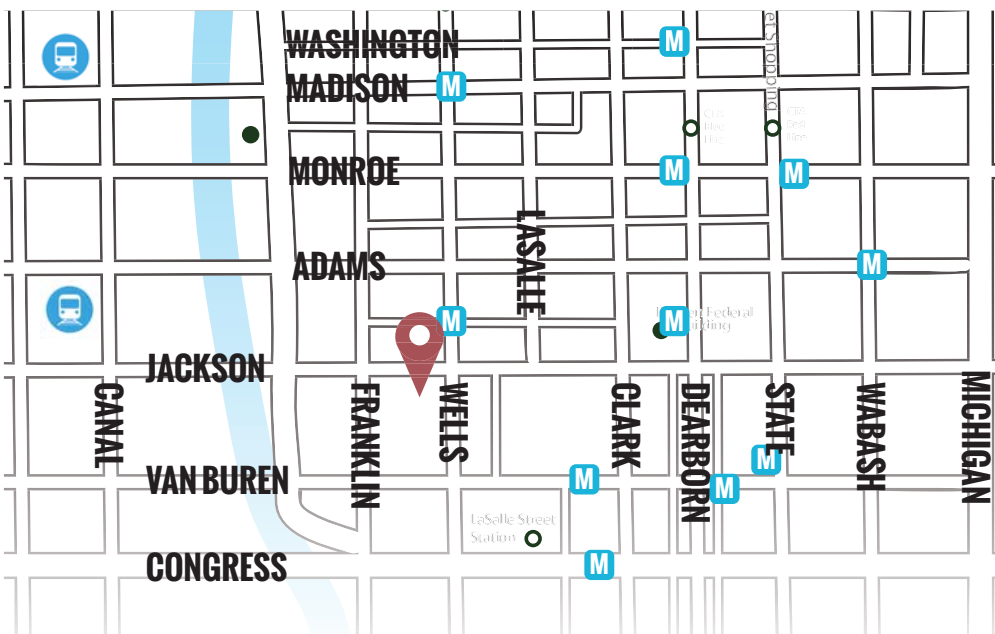
