

original Otis elevator equipment, preserved today



built in 1911 as the Chicago headquarters of the Otis Elevator Company, 600 West Jackson rose to the center of architectural history and modern innovation. Otis—whose safety elevator made vertical cities possible—selected this building for its operations during the rise of the skyscraper era.



designed by Daniel Burnham with a steel frame, expansive windows, and classic masonry detailing, the building provides copious sun-filled, efficient office space.
