

# Motor Row Collection



For the first three decades of the 20th century, Motor Row was a gateway to America's car culture. According to an article published in the Chicago Tribune on Feb. 10, 1906, "Chicago has the most imposing automobile row of any city in the country, and claim for a world's record might well be made without much chance of there being any dispute."

Over 110 years later, Motor Row is making a comeback. Just a few miles south of the Loop, Motor Row is filled with history and, now, newly renovated office and retail space.

You can find your way down to Motor Row by taking the Green Line to Cermak-McCormick Place, Red Line to Cermak-Chinatown, or on the scenic Lake Shore Drive.
